

Arithmetic equivalence for central simple algebras over number fields

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In this talk we discuss to what extent the zeta function of a finite dimension central simple algebra A , over a number field F , gives information about A and F . This is a natural generalization of the notion of arithmetic equivalence on number fields. As a particular case, we obtain that quaternion algebras over $\mathbb{Q}$ are completely characterized by their zeta functions.
