

Sheffer-Dunkl polynomials and characterizations

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Sheffer polynomials can be characterized using different Stieltjes integrals. These families of polynomials have been recently extended to the Dunkl context using umbral calculus. In this way some classical operators as the derivative operator or the difference operator are replaced as analogous operators in the Dunkl universe.
