

Subgroup Conjugacy Separability of Residually Free Groups

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A group G is said to be subgroup conjugacy separable if for any pair of non-conjugate finitely generated subgroups $H_1, H_2 \leq G$ there exists a finite quotient of G where the images of H_1 and H_2 are non-conjugate. After a brief history we shall discuss this property for finitely presented residually free groups as well as some related properties.

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
